Insert the word "various" if more than one foreign port of lading is involved, and show the individual ports of lading by name immediately below the description of goods in vertical column number 3.

Column No. 3

If used as entry pursuant to Section 123.7, Customs Regulations, as amended, prepare form in duplicate and show name of shipper, value, and tariff item number immediately below description of goods in vertical column number 3.

Paperwork Reduction Act Notice: The Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980 says we must tell you why we are collecting this information, how we will use it and whether you have to give it to us. We ask for the information to carry out the Customs Service laws of the United States. This form is used by vessel carriers (under 5 net tons), railroads, or persons in charge of a vehicle to list baggage or other merchandise being conveyed into the United States otherwise than by sea from Canada or Mexico. It is mandatory.
